

Outgoing Mail

You will have 2 opportunities to send mail home.

1. **Via the Event's mail system** (modern postal service)

- Bring a modern pre-addressed stamped envelope.
- Mail will be picked up from camp Wednesday AM.
- This will be put directly into the U.S. Mail.

2. **Via the Bemis-Dal Bello Mail Service** (period/modern mail service)

- This mail will be collected at Battalion HQ, up until the end of the event.
- Put your letter in a period envelope with a period 3cent stamp on it, OR:
- Put it in a period envelope without a period stamp. These unstamped envelopes are "Soldiers Letters" which must be signed by the Company Commander or Battalion Field/Staff. By this time, soldiers could send letters home without a 3 cent stamp, but it was marked "Due 3" as the receiver would need to foot the bill.
- These letters will be processed by the Postmaster Bemis, and then send via modern U.S. Mail to your recipient.
- Include a modern pre-addressed stamped envelope, so we can put your period envelope in it...
- OR... at least give us the modern address to send your period letter to. Put it inside your period envelop ... which we will check and then seal. Give us 50cents per outgoing letter that you do not provide the pre-addressed/stamped modern envelop.
